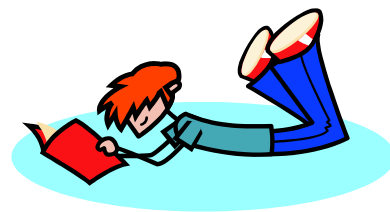

# BOOK CLUBS

We've been busy revamping our book clubs! Book clubs will now meet in 3 month terms, beginning in February. After the February-March-April term we will take a summer break. We will meet again in the fall (September-October-November) and take a break for the winter holidays.

There is a \$20 participation fee for each term, to ensure that only those who truly want to participate will sign up for book clubs. There will be a limit of 8 participants in each group.

As usual, each group will read one book per month, and we will meet twice a month per book. The first meeting will involve an activity to introduce the book, and the second meeting will be a discussion of the book.

There are two age groups. The 9 - 10 year old group will meet on Tuesdays, and the 11 - 12 year old group will meet on Fridays. The first meeting for 9 - 10 year olds is February 9, and the first meeting for 11 - 12 year olds is February 12. Both groups meet at 4:00.
